School bags are back from today as we had a number of difficulties in September with safety on the stairs, homework etc. Make sure to wipe down the schoolbag regularly and keep it light.

At all times we take direction from the authorities who have stated that while we "need to minimise risk, we also need to return school life to a sense of normality".

A survey will be sent out next week to gauge the demand for a Homework Club – if it is feasible and enough families are interested., we may begin it on a trial basis, with each class remaining in their pods and bubbles at all times.
